1. Goals and objectives of the competition:

- revival, retention and demonstration of national culture • development of the best examples of contemporary art
- popularization of the work of composers of Kazakhstan
- identification and support of talented youth
- improving the level of performing skills
- Stimulating the creative potential of children and youth

2. The competition is held in the following categories:

- «Compulsory piano»
- «Piano ensemble» (duo)

3. Age categories:

For students of secondary schools, art schools:

- I age group is 6-8 years old
- II age group 9-10 years old
- III age group 11-12 years old
- IV age group 13-14 years old

For students of secondary schools, specialized schools and colleges/colleges:

- I age group 6-8 years
- II age group 9-10 years old
- III age group 11-13 years old
- IV age group 14-16 years old
- V age group 17-19 years old

For students (conservatory, Institute of Arts, university academy, etc.)

I age group: students of the 1st year of study

II age group: students of 2 years of study

4. Program requirements:

The nomination "Mandatory piano" (program requirements for all age groups)

1. One work of the Baroque or Classicism era
2. One work of the participant's choice
(time requirement -no more than 20 minutes)

Nomination "Piano Ensemble" (program requirements for all age groups)

Two works of different character at the participant's choice (no more than 20 minutes)

5. Terms of the competition:

The competition is open to: students of secondary schools, art schools, secondary schools, specialized schools, colleges / colleges, universities of the department / department of compulsory (general) piano. The competition consists of one round for all nominations. Participants provide a link (links) to a video posted on the Internet on a **YouTube** channel with open access to the link. The video recording must be recorded in one or more video files (at the contestant's choice, it is allowed to record the entire performance of the program in one file or in parts). The video recording must meet the concert criteria.

All works are performed for memory, participants in the nomination "Piano Ensemble" are allowed to perform according to the notes. The order of performance of the works is set by the participants themselves, according to the program requirements. Performances will be evaluated according to a **100-point system**. Video recording should be carried out without turning off and stopping the video camera from the beginning to the end of the work being performed. During the execution of the program, the contestant(s) and the instrument(s) must be clearly visible in the frame. Performance under a phonogram is not allowed.

In the description of the video, specify the following information:

1. Last name and first name of the contestant(s)
2. Nomination, age category
3. Country, city, name of the educational institution
4. The competition program
5. Full name of the teacher

6. The jury of the competition:

The jury of the competition consists of famous teachers, professors and associate professors, soloists, art critics, music critics, public figures from around the world. The jury of the competition has the right to divide the prizes or not to award any of them. The jury's decision is final and cannot be reviewed. The participants who won prizes (I, II, III) are awarded with Diplomas with the title of laureate. Participants who have shown a high level, but are not among the winners, are awarded Diplomas with the title of diploma holder of the competition. The winners of the Grand Prix will receive cash prizes. Additionally, cash prizes will be awarded to the laureates by the decision of the jury, musical sets, special diplomas and prizes from the partners of the competition, special diplomas named after Nagim Mendygaliev and monetary incentives. Teachers who have prepared the contestants are awarded with letters of thanks. By submitting an application, the participant agrees to the ORGANIZING COMMITTEE to process personal data sent by e-mail and post it on the official website.
